## Year Six Reflection


I would like to take this final opportunity to celebrate and congratulate our Year Six cohort of children as they come towards the end of their journey at St Margaret Mary's.

## School Dinners Change

Over the course of the year we have brought in changes to school menus and the sourcing of ingredients. We believe the result of this has been a school meal provision that is home-made from scratch, nutritious and of real quality. I know that this has been very positively commented upon by our children and also parents who attended our taster sessions and could not believe the quality of food.

As a result of rising food and energy costs we are having to change our school meal charge from  $5^{th}$  September to £2.55 per day. This is something that we have tried to absorb for a number of years but are now unable to. The increase is in-line with other schools that we have contacted and the national DfE recommended charge rate for primary schools. Although increasing we believe this to be really good value for money. Many thanks for your understanding with this.



# Building Works: Kitchen Rebuild

Over the summer holidays work will commence on a school kitchen rebuild. The plan is to build a kitchen onto our school hall, locating this on the elevation side of the Junior Playground. When completed the plan is to demolish the existing kitchen and dining hall, with meals being served from the school hall, as is usual in most schools. As a future improvement to our school building we are pleased to have been given this money and opportunity by the Diocese of Salford. We expect the site and all health and safety measures to be set up during the summer holidays, with works commencing during the autumn term. Meetings are to take place over the holidays and I look forward to updating you further when we return in September. Please note the LSC Holiday Club will still operate as planned and as normal.
