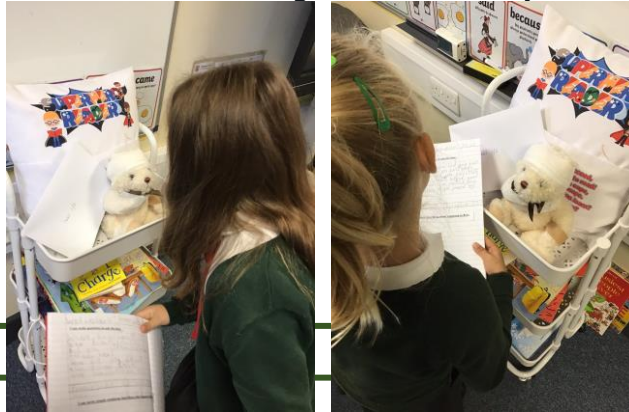
### EYFS News
